NATURE AND SCOPE:

The Aquatic Staff team provides high quality programs and services to our members and participants, and works as a member of the Health, Fitness and Aquatics program team.

Reporting to the Aquatic Leads, **Lifeguards** are responsible for maintaining the safety and enjoyment of all swimmers. This includes but is not limited to providing direct supervision, educating the public regarding safe swimming habits, prevention and/or intervention in unsafe or emergency situations, and performing first aid as required. **Swim Instructors** are also required to plan and deliver progressive swimming instruction in accordance with YMCA Standards, and to complete required administrative duties.

QUALIFICATIONS (as relevant to the specific position):

- Current Standard First Aid / CPR-C / AED Certification (St. John's, Lifesaving Society, Red Cross, Canadian Ski Patrol)
- Current Bronze Cross Award
- Participation in a Pre-NLS Course; candidates who hold a current National Lifeguard Award (NL) will be given preference
- Current YMCA or Red Cross Assistant Swim Instructor Award (YMCA award preferred) or willing to obtain
- Candidates who hold a current YMCA Swim Instructor Award will be given preference
- Willing to teach Aquatic Fitness classes; experience preferred but not required, must be willing to train

HOURS: Due to the seasonal peaks in our operation, the work schedule will flex to accommodate the needs of our members and participants. The shifts may vary including weekends, evenings and early mornings as required.
