

# Summer Day Camp Volunteer Opportunity



## Role

Summer Day Camp Volunteers work alongside our Senior Day Camp Counsellors to facilitate and assist with on-site supervision and operation of our YMCA Summer Day Camps, providing opportunities for campers to learn and play. Responsibilities may include set up and/or take down of the program area, providing quality instruction, ensuring camper safety and happiness, and providing a positive environment. Experienced applicants may facilitate programs on their own upon request and demonstrated ability to do so.

Summer Day Camp Volunteers will represent the YMCA in a responsible, respectful and professional manner, respond to or direct participant inquiries or concerns, be positive, welcoming and helpful, champion YMCA Clean Culture, and give timely feedback to supervisor regarding issues and/or suggestions related to the program.

## Requirements

- Experience with children
- Friendly and outgoing attitude
- Ability to follow directions and work with minimal supervision
- Report early and in uniform for scheduled volunteer times
- Must participate in orientation and training sessions (including Child Protection Training) as required
- Volunteers over 16 yrs old: Satisfactory Police Records Check and Vulnerable Sector Check within the past 90 days
- Current Standard First Aid and CPR-C an asset

## Time Commitment

- One half day or day per week (9 weeks)
- May be able to accommodate a varied schedule, be prepared to discuss your needs during your interview
