- **Be a voice that matters.** As a voting member of the Association, your perspective helps guide decisions that shape our impact across the region.

- **Stay connected.** Board terms begin in the fall and run for 1 year, with an expectation of serving for at least two consecutive years to ensure continuity and impact.


